

Parenting Journey Home Visiting Program – Lunenburg County

The Parenting Journey Home Visiting Program is funded by the Nova Scotia Department of Community Services, Child Youth & Family Supports Division. The South Shore Family Resource Association has had a service level agreement with DCS since 2008 to provide the PJHV program in Lunenburg County.

The Parenting Journey program is a voluntarily program intended to promote the optimal development and well-being of children and youth by providing family support through purposeful, goal-based home-based visitation. Families with children and youth aged 3-16 are eligible for the program.

Support may be included in the following areas:

- Child/Youth Growth and Development
- Parent-Child/Youth Relationship
- Family Life Management
- Community
