These camps are FREE.

Purpose:

Transition to School is a program designed to support your child and help them feel pride in their accomplishments. The philosophy around Transition to School is based on positive self-esteem, kindness, becoming familiar with their school, their classroom and meeting some of their classmates. It will also provide an opportunity for your child to experience learning in a small group setting prior to their entry into grade Primary.

Additional Information:

Please ensure that your child is wearing clothing and footwear that is appropriate for a moderate amount of physical activity and possibly outdoor play, weather permitting. We recommend you send a water bottle, hat and make sure sunscreen is applied prior to dropping your child off. We ask that you have your children’s belongings labeled with their name. Please provide a nut free lunch for your child each day.
