Nobody's Perfect registration required, Child Care provided, Offered in 6 Sessions on Mondays: January 28th, February 2nd, 9th, 23rd, March 2nd, and 9th, 10 am to 12 noon. Nobody's Perfect is designed to strengthen positive parenting skills and gives parents a safe place to meet others with children of the same age and with whom they share interests and concerns. For parents and caregivers of children newborn to age 6 years.

Tuesdays

Baby and Me -Drop in (ages newborn to 18 months, Child Care available for older children) Tuesday January 6th, 13th, 20th, and 27th, 10:30 am to 12 noon. Caregivers of babies have an opportunity to socialize, share experiences, and access resources.
